History of NAMB - North American Mission Board (Part 4 of 5)

1949 - SBC requests Radio Commission to serve as central agency in producing audio-visual materials.

1950 - Baptist Brotherhood of the South becomes the Brotherhood Commission of the SBC, with offices in Memphis, Tenn.

1951 - Radio Commission expands into television.

1954 - The Royal Ambassador movement, which had been sponsored and promoted by WMU since its birth as an organization, is moved from WMU to the Brotherhood Commission.

1954 - Radio Commission changes name to Radio and Television Commission (RTVC) and moves to Fort Worth, Texas.

1960 - Work with ethnic/language-culture groups becomes HMB's largest program in budget and number of missionaries.
